1. The Organizer is the Barbados Association of Dragsters and Drifters Inc. (BADD) Address: PO Box 213W, Worthing, Ch. Ch.

- 2. The event is held under the Regulations of the Barbados Motoring Federation (BMF) and their Permit# xxxxx and the Organizer's Regulations.
- 3. The Competition will be held on Saturday 6 May 2017 from 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM and Sunday 7 May from 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM
- 4. Venue: Bushy Park Racing Circuit, St. Philip
- 5. A completed Event Entry Form must be handed in by 5:00 PM on Friday 5 May 2017 to Motorsport Services, #7 Barbados Hardware, Haggatt Hall, St. Michael. <u>Event Registration can only be done at MOTORSPORT SERVICES, Monday to Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM (436-0962).</u> They have kindly agreed to open until 5:00 PM on Thursday May 4 and Friday May 5. Entries <u>WILL NOT</u> be taken after this date.
- 6. Competitor's Entrance Fee is \$40.00 and the insurance charge is \$40.00.

 NB: A competitor who causes Third Party Property Damage is required to pay the first \$1,000.00 of any Third Party claim accepted by insurers.
- 7. If fewer than 8 entries have been received by 4 PM on Tuesday May 2 2017, the event will be cancelled and all existing entry fees will be refunded.
- 8. Only members of B.A.D.D and the Board's invited quest(s) can take part.
- 9. Competitors must have a valid BMF National A or B License, or have successfully applied and paid for same before submitting the Entry Form and making payment at Motorsport Services.
- 10. On Arrival at the Pit Entrance all persons must sign in with the Pit Entry Official. Competitors and Officials have different Sign-in Sheets. Please ensure that you use the correct sheet.
- 11. Competitors will be allotted three (3) Pit Passes inclusive of the driver. These will be given out at the sign-in station at the pit gate on race day. Competitors are allowed a maximum of one service vehicle per entry.

- 12. **The Drivers Briefing Meeting** will be held at 12:00 PM in the pits. It is **MANDATORY** for drivers to attend the Briefing Meeting.
- 13. Track Entry for Competitors and Officials will be via the Pit Entrance.
- 14. **Scrutineering:** Cars will be scrutineered between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Competitors must have their jack and axle stands on hand when presenting their cars to the Scrutineers. Competitors arriving after 2 PM may lose some or all of their qualifying runs depending on their arrival time. Cars arriving after the end of qualifying will not be included in eliminations but may take part in grudge matches.
- 15. Minimum height of front spoiler off the ground is 4 inches.
- 16. All competing vehicles must meet the Sound Control Level of 114 decibels dB (A).
- 17. All Regulation checks will be done by the BADD Officials. Any unofficial person found conducting such test, or any check normally performed by the BADD appointed Officials, will be immediately evicted from the Pit pending further disciplinary action.
- 18. Qualifying for the "Tree Position" will start at **3:00 PM on Saturday 6 May**. There will be a minimum of 2 runs per car except late arrivals as per 14 above. Only BADD members may take part in the qualifying and eliminations.
- 19. Eliminations will take place on **Sunday 7 May at 3:30 PM**. Any competitors who did not qualify on Saturday 6 May and wish to take part in Eliminations must notify the Chief Timer of the bracket that they wish to be placed in. They will be at the bottom of that bracket. **All Trees will be deemed FINAL by 1 PM on Sunday 7 May**.
- 20. After all eliminations have taken place there will be a series of grudge matches. Eliminations and grudge matches will be started using the "tree". BADD safety regulations apply to all participants in eliminations and grudge matches.
- 21. Eliminations will be single runs, not 2-best-of-3.
- 22. All races will be **1/8 of a Mile** (One Eighth of a Mile) in distance.
- 23. Brackets will be half-second brackets, with the exception of 6 seconds and under, which will be whole second brackets.
- 24. Only water may be used on the track surface in the burn-out area.
- 25. Competitors who will no longer be participating in the event due to mechanical failure or for any other reason must report this to the Pit Manager within 5 minutes of the end of the Qualifying Session or Race in which they last took part.
- 26. Withdrawal withdrawal of entry prior to closing date of entries full refund of entry and insurance. Withdrawal of entry after closing date of entries, or DNS full refund of insurance and \$20 of entry fee.
- 27. **Absolutely no speeding (5km per hour) at Pit Entry or on Pit Lane**. Further, on approach to the start area, competitors must stop at the staging point until instructed to proceed into the burnout/start box. No burnouts are permitted in the staging area without permission from the Race Director or Chief Starter.

- 28. Competitors must at all times adhere to the instructions and flag signals of the marshals.
- 29. Competitors will be held accountable for the actions of their pit crew on all race and official practice days.
- 30. Competitors or their crew may not come up to the Start/Official Area unless summoned by the Stewards. In all cases competitors must seek clearance from the Pit Manager before crossing the infield and track, if summoned to the Start/Official Area.
- 31. Competitors, pit crew or officials who are believed to have consumed alcohol or drugs on race day will be summoned to the Medical Personnel where an on the spot examination may be conducted by BADD's Medical Personnel. Any person found guilty of breaching this ASR will be immediately disqualified and may be liable to further action being taken by the disciplinary committee. **Smoking allowed in designated areas only**.
- 32. Competitors whose cars **do not** conform to BADD's 2014 Regulations, Appendices, and these ASR's will **not** be allowed to compete.
- 33. Competition Numbers must be affixed to cars/bikes/trucks so that they may easily be visible from any side before leaving pits. Numbers can either be placed on the front doors or rear door glass in the case of cars and on the side faring or gas tank in the case of motorcycles. They must be no less than 6" high and 2.5" wide.
- 34. Competitors must not bring their competition vehicles into the competition area unless they have passed scrutineering by the official scrutineers, nor should they encourage non-service crew into this restricted area. Failure to comply may result in immediate disqualification from competition, no refund of the Entry Fee and possible further disciplinary action being taken against the competitor by a disciplinary committee.
- 35. The decision of the Race Director in all competition matters is Final. Competitors wishing to protest the decision may do so by filing the appropriate form with the Event Secretary so that it can be referred to the Stewards.
- 36. Competitors failing to follow the directives of the Race Director, Race Officials and Marshalls may be liable to immediate disqualification and also, further possible action being taken by a disciplinary committee.
- 37. Championship Points shall be awarded as per the championship regulations on the BADD website.
- 38. Passes DO NOT automatically permit access to the Staging and Competition areas.
- 39. Great emphasis will be paid to all aspects of safety as it relates to vehicles and behavior in the Pit and Competition enclosures. The Race Director shall have the Authority at any time to disqualify any competitor from the Event for violation of any decision, rule or regulation laid down by Barbados Association of Dragsters and Drifters Inc.
